Kea Academy provides leading educational programmes. This brochure lays out the Summer 2024 programme. Life Skills is “a behaviour change or development approach designed to address a balance of three areas: knowledge, attitude and skills” (UNICEF). The Kea programme encompasses 15 life skills categorised into five themes: Personal Development, Employability, Learning, Active Citizenship and Wellness.

According to UNICEF, the first four are the basic life skills essential in the world we live in today. Valuable skills for life are not extensively covered in school. As a result, young adults are not sufficiently prepared for life or careers.

Consequently, we have carefully curated a Global Leaders Success Programmes for Teenagers' to teach life skills, support socialisation, and promote exercise and healthy living. The programme is a chance for young adults to learn life skills that will prepare them for life and any modern career, encouraging creativity and building confidence.

# the kea Method

## For All Students

In the world of Kea, we have designed the programme around terminology from space as we believe that it beautifully illustrates the impossible becoming possible.

- LIFE SKILLS** also known as → “Stars”
- THEMES** → “Galaxies”
- CORE CLASS** → “Constellation”  
(formed by various ‘stars’)
- WORKSHOP** → “Comet”
- PROJECT** → “Planet”
- DAILY SKILLS** → “Shooting Stars”

We believe that CORE CLASSES are fundamental to the development of the young adults we work with.

Our core classes teach theoretical knowledge, linking it to the 15 life skills. These classes take the forms of interactive lectures, case-studies and research and are designed annually by experts to represent current affairs and developments.

All students partake in these galaxies, becoming well-rounded individuals through our expansive syllabus.

### Learning to Know: Learning

### Learning to Do: Employability & Careers

Our Employability and Careers “Galaxy” will ensure students leave with a sense of purpose and meaningful direction in their future selves; concerning future career goals. Students will learn about various career directions which inspire them while also learning how to apply themselves in an interview setting.

### Learning to Be: Personal Empowerment

Our Personal Empowerment “galaxy” explores approaches for self-growth and autonomy across many settings. 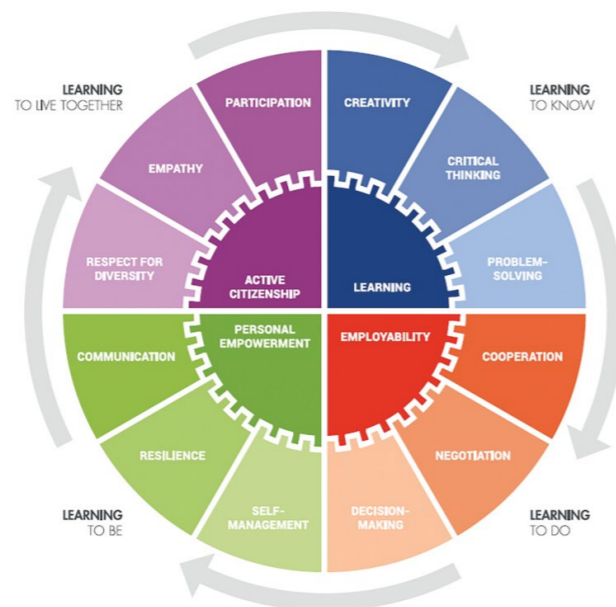

## GLOBAL LEADERS PROGRAMME

Our global leaders' programme covers various life skills essential to becoming a visionary and global leader. Our programme is carefully designed alongside experts to ensure that UNICEF's life skills (Learning, Employability, Empowerment, Active Citizenship) are met with the additional 'Wellness' skills.

We use a blended learning approach by offering classes, lectures and project-based learning through the various projects students will undertake. The main projects students prepare include; Business Plan Presentation, Kea Ted Talk and the Social Impact project. There will also be a project-based assignment for each Kea taster course.

In this programme, students cover the essential topics for becoming a visionary and compassionate leader. Our syllabus for the programme includes; creative thinking, methods of research, learning techniques, career design, entrepreneurship, public speaking, presentation skills, different forms of investment, business, trading, networking and communication, time management, productivity, emotional intelligence, global sustainability, social responsibility, inclusion and diversity, social and charitable enterprises, healthy-living, nutrition, mindfulness, meditation and sports. The programme is always different for yearly students, with different case studies, experts and more.

Students also get involved in discussions about the state of the world, making a difference, impressing an audience, creating persuasive arguments, networking effectively and gaining interview skills.

# Programmes



## ENGLISH AND GLOBAL LEADERS SUCCESS PROGRAMME

This course explores the main components of improving English Language skills no matter the student's English level. It enables students to use their linguistics skills in discussions, projects, activities and more. Students learn to read, write and speak in English at a beginner, intermediate or advanced level. Students also participate in activities and discussions with native English speakers enhancing their learning further and providing a fantastic blend of English and Global Leadership. We aim to ensure that each student who leaves the programme has visibly improved their language skills and feels empowered. In the past, we had beginners that did not speak a word of English; however, after attending the course, they improved their English level dramatically to an intermediate level. Students will also take final examinations, present their projects and receive certifications to showcase their progress.

# kea Taster Courses (Optional)

## INTRODUCTION TO CRYPTOCURRENCY'

## ACCOMMODATION

### Rooms

Accommodation is provided for the entirety of the programme. Students stay in Cambridge college accommodation. Each student has a bedroom, access to a bathroom and shared standard rooms. Kea Academy staff stay on-site. Students are accommodated in same-sex dormitories. Students are grouped with others of similar age and a mixture of nationalities where students can make friends from all over the world. All rooms are fully furnished with a standard set of furniture: a bed, wardrobe, desk, desk lamp, desk chair, bookcase, chest of drawers, bedside table, an armchair or easy chair, notice board, and picture hooks.



### Meals

The school will provide all meals during the student's stay. Hot Breakfast, Lunch and Hot Dinner will be served for students in the shared dining room where they can interact and discuss their experiences. Snacks and packed lunches for trips will also be provided; students must specify dietary requirements in the Application form. We offer the students highly nutritious, freshly prepared food throughout the day.

Our dedicated team is also always on hand to answer any allergy queries. Our menus blend traditional with worldwide flavours to cater for our diverse student base. In addition, we frequently provide themed menus to support learning, encourage a cultural palate, and research new ideas to keep our menus fresh and inspired.

## CORE CLASSES

All students must take the core classes to achieve the necessary 15 life skills that will support their growth as young adults. The core classes will be taught using learning techniques to provide for a unique learning experience. Students are taught problem-solving within different areas of life. The classes are based not on qualifying students but on looking for and honing their skills and abilities. Curiosity is nurtured and creativity is encouraged in an open learning environment.

## PROJECTS

Projects are essential to forming the substance and application of life skills. Therefore, all students will be working on projects in diverse groups, helping the students utilise what they learned during different workshops and combining that to create a winning and diversely skilled team.



## GUEST SPEAKERS

We invite unique speakers passionate about speaking on mental health, leadership, business, diversity, equality & inclusion, and much more. Visionaries will share their experiences, inspire young adults, and offer their expertise on various subject matters.

# travel & transfers

Students are responsible for arranging their flights. Kea Academy offers an optional airport transfer service every arrival and departure day from/to London Heathrow and Gatwick airports from 11 am to 4pm only. Kea Academy will ensure that students are met in person and taken to their Cambridge campus. Students may also travel to Cambridge alone or with their families; however, they must provide their transfer details before arrival. For students under 18 arriving at the airport, one of our Kea Academy staff will meet the student in the arrivals hall and transport them directly to the campus. Our staff will be identifiable by their Kea T-shirt and a sign with the student's name and Kea Academy name and logo. Students requiring private airport transfers at times outside of scheduled pick-up time, must pay the transfer fee when applying for their Kea Academy programme..

## Insurance and Visas

Parents must fill in a medical form and provide medical insurance details for their child before their arrival. We do recommend each student takes out comprehensive travel insurance. As Kea Academy is accredited by the British Accreditation Council, we can provide a visa support letter for students.

## Entry Requirements

Kea Academy programmes are open to students between 13-18 from all over the world. Students are recommended to write a 250-word personal statement for our educators to be better aware of the student's aspirations for the future, helping us tailor our experience to ensure we cover specific areas of interest or invite the relevant guest speakers.

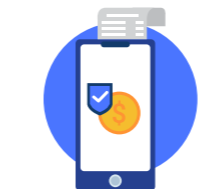
